Halnaker Windmill **BOXGROVE**

Description:	A prominent landmark. Built in 1740. Restored from a complete ruin in 1934. Brick shell with no internal workings. Red brick with blue headers, covered with a thin coating of burnt Sussex tiles. Octagonal cap of beehive shape with finial made of fiberglass on a wooden structure.

Reason for Risk:	Historic building with original use redundant.
Registered:	1993
Last Assessed:	27 March 2012
Ownership:	West Sussex County Council
Current Status:	Three sweeps replaced 27 March 2012. Repointing of brickwork to upper levels being undertaken in lime mortar. Tile hanging cracking and failing throughout. Some tile and mortar fragments falling away from surface. Door missing. Continue to monitor.
