Current Status:	Main roof structure appears to be under stress with failure resulting in places. Tiling pattern remains legible. Victorian carved barge-boards in-tact and repairable. Tower and porch suffer from loss of tiles and structural failure. Tower partially lost due to failed roof structure. Severe fractures to NE and NW corner of north protrusion suggesting the volume is pulling away from the core. Iron rain goods lost. Majority of the leaded windows are missing. Internally, structural beam supported by metal prop. Lath and plaster ceilings failing in parts.
