



Why sign up to the Developer and Partner Charter?

Businesses are increasingly judged by their customers, employees and general public for the values they demonstrate and choose to represent.

Signing up to this charter, while not binding in a legal sense, is a public demonstration of those values and is something that all parties should be rightly proud of. In this regard the council would encourage signatories to publicly declare their support for the charter, their commitment to its principles and willingness to publicise progress against it.

Developers and partners signing up to the charter will be issued with a charter certificate by the council. This enables both the council and signatories to publicly demonstrate and illustrate their commitment and support for the charter.

We will provide you with the opportunity to:

- Engage with the Apprenticeship team at Chichester College
- Improve site security with support from Chichester District Council and the Local Police
- Develop communication with local communities
- Support local businesses
- Get assistance from the Economic Development Team

What happens once your business has signed up?

You will be assigned a liaison from the Economic Development Service, who will contact you to introduce themselves. They will work with you to ascertain what support you need. They will provide you with information and contacts at any relevant organisations, businesses and groups, and be your first point of call if you have any problems or questions.

The Economic Development Service will monitor any progress you have made via a six monthly questionnaire.
