A Definition for Community Led Housing?

Group of national CLH bodies have worked in partnership to develop a definition which is based on **core principles** rather than hard and fast rules:

- A requirement that **meaningful community engagement and consent occurs throughout the process**. The community does not necessarily have to initiate and manage the development process, or build the homes themselves, though many do.
- The **local community group or organisation owns, manages or stewards the homes and in a manner of their choosing**.
- A requirement that the **benefits to the local area and/or specified community must be clearly defined and legally protected in perpetuity** e.g. through an asset lock.
- A **'community' can be both a community of place or a community of interest**.
- **Membership of that organisation or group must be open to anyone** within that defined community.

Why do it?

Benefits of Community Led Housing

- Build houses that the community needs - older people, young families, young people, communities of interest..
- Build affordable housing - that stays affordable in perpetuity
- Mobilise local support for building more housing
- Build homes where developers are not interested
- Regenerate local communities - new build and refurbishment
- Recycle income back into your community organisation and your area
- Rental income can help fund wrap around support services to tenants/ residents

Neighbourhood Planning Support Programme

- Technical support packages provide professional support to undertake Housing Needs Assessments, site assessments and allocations, viability studies, CRTB Orders etc....
- £9k grant for Neighbourhood Plans
- Allocating housing sites = additional grant up to £15k

Locality's Early Stage Support Programme in Chichester

Support from Locality staff and CLH consultants to:

- Explore local housing needs
- Find the right CLH model for you

- Pairing CLH practitioners with you
- Funding from CDC for visits to other schemes, legal fees for incorporation, joining membership bodies, publicity, technical surveys..etc.
