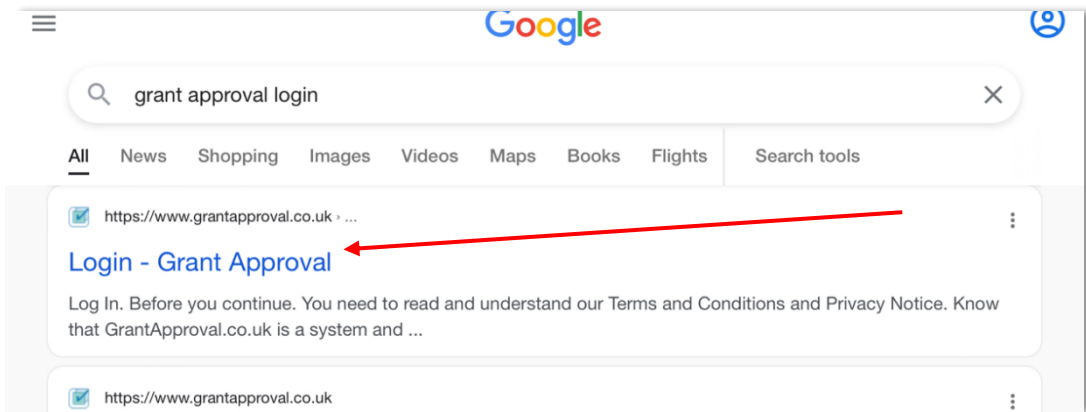
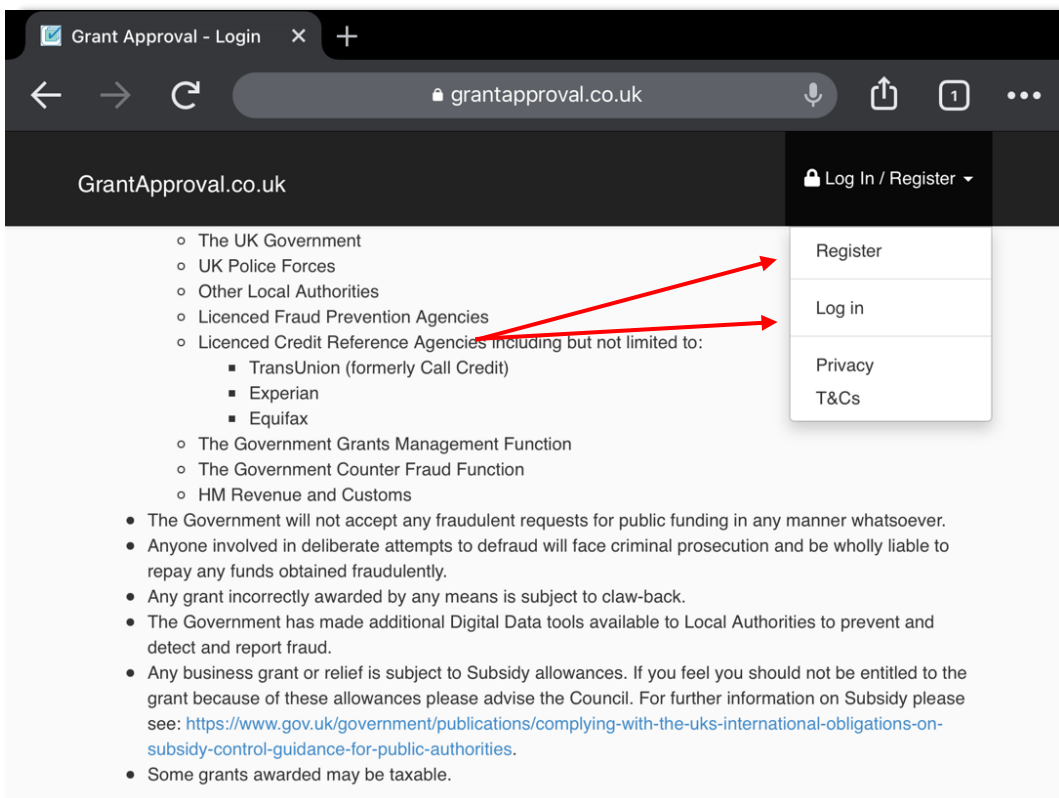



1- Go to www.grantapproval.co.uk

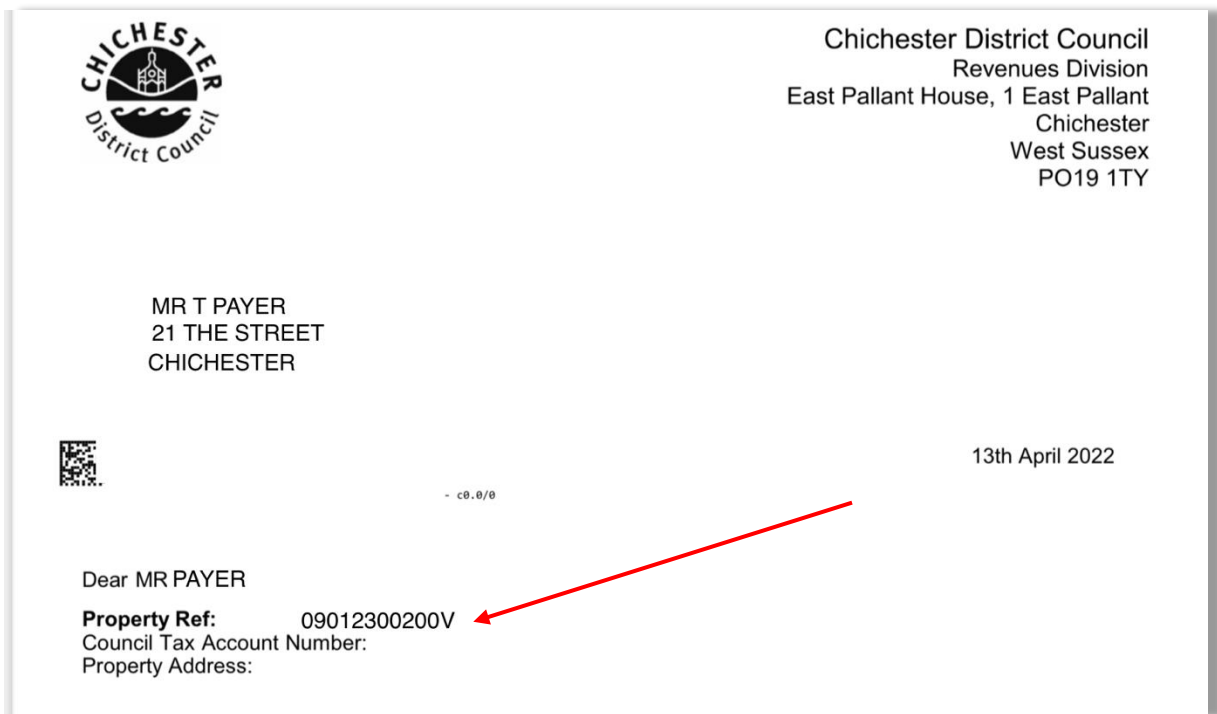
4- When you have successfully logged in, you should select Chichester from the drop down list of local authority's.



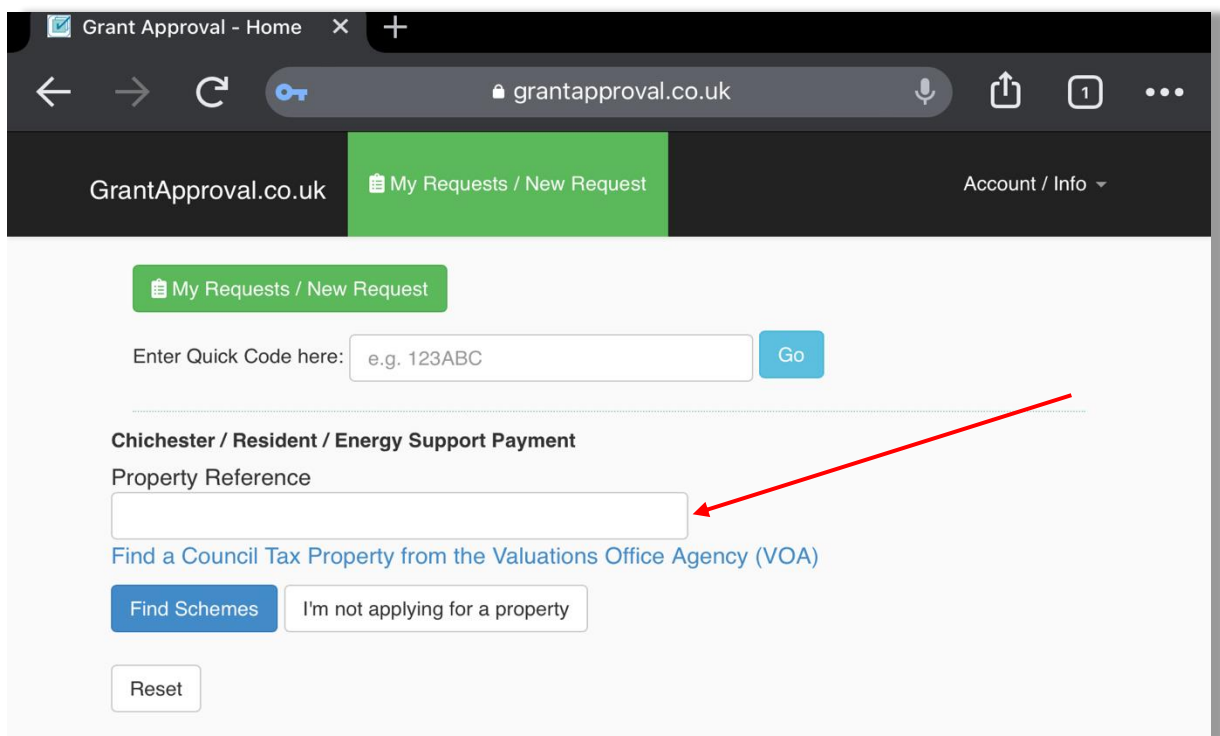
5- You should then click on the blue box “continue as a resident”.




- 6- **Enter your Property Reference Number as shown on the letter you received from us regarding the rebate. The reference should be 12 characters long.**
