Additional Information

- Situated at the end of South Bank and highly visible from the canal towpath, this is the last remaining example of the 14 swing bridges on the Portsmouth & Arundel Canal.
- Built in 1820, the bridge was originally situated at Hunston and named after W. S. Poyntz MP.
- The bridge has been restored to working order and remains a significant feature of the industrial revolution in this region.
