





Itchenor Bosham Circular

Market Cross to Itchenor/Bosham
flat with mixed surfaces

Suitable for riders of all abilities and all bike types



fact

It is said King Canute once stood on the shores of Bosham Harbour and ordered the tide to go back to prove he did not have special powers as king.

fact

Did you know? During the Plague, people of Bosham took food to inhabitants of Chichester, who were confined within the City Walls. Because of this charity, they were granted the right to sell fish in any market in England without paying tolls, the rights to free mooring, wild-fowling, and fishing within the waters of Bosham Harbour.

fact

Bosham church is the only church depicted on the Bayeux Tapestry.

A coffin thought to contain the daughter of King Canute was found under the floor in 1865.

fact

Fishbourne Roman Palace was built in the 1st century AD and was re-discovered by accident during the digging of a water main trench in 1960.

11 At the end of Chequer Lane turn right onto Main Road and follow the dedicated cycle lane through Fishbourne.

10 From Shore Road, continue along Bosham Lane which becomes Walton Lane by Rectory Farm. Continue to Chequer Lane and turn right as signposted to Chichester.

9 Take care exiting the ferry onto shingle and make your way north to the road. Bearing left, follow the road around the water's edge to Bosham Quay.

8 Turn right and follow the road to West Itchenor bearing right when you pass the church (leaving the Salterns Way). Proceed through the village until reaching the ferry which is based at the end of the jetty. Enjoy the crossing!

7 After the church, continue straight on and Church Lane becomes Westlands Lane which is a concrete road. Proceed for 450m and turn left through the gate before the farm onto uneven clay track to Shipton Green Lane.

12 After Barreg Cycles, turn left following cycle path to Salthill Road and continue on cycle route towards Fishbourne Roman Palace. Pass to the left of the Palace and follow the route to the underpass at Fishbourne Road East. Continue the path under the bridge taking care crossing the railway line and follow the cycle route along Westgate to the Market Cross.

1 Start at The Cross and head west following the cycle route on the road towards Westgate.

2 Take care crossing the railway line near the entrance to Bishop Luffa School turning right onto Fishbourne Road East.

3 Continue through the underpass and turn left at Fishbourne Road West following signs for the cycle path, taking care when crossing the main road.

fact

Chichester Harbour is a Site of Special Scientific Interest and is a Special Protection Area for wild birds and a Special Area of Conservation and a RAMSAR site.

4 After 200m turn right into Appledram Lane and after a further 400m, leave the lane and join the Salterns Way cycle path to West Itchenor. The path later returns to Appledram lane. Continue to the T-junction and turn right and first left onto a farm road.

5 Bear right at the farm onto uneven track for 850m, proceed through woodland and emerge at Chichester Marina. Turn left and proceed around the marina keeping it on your right and after the car park barrier, turn right and follow the canal to the lock by the Yacht Club. You must dismount to cross the bridge and follow the footpath for 100m remounting when you join the road.

6 Turn left onto Lock Lane and follow the road to the T-junction with Church Lane. Turn right.
